- 2. Stillman illustrates the major difference between Gen X (e.g. his father) and Gen Z with the help of a meeting that caused a fight because he did not tell his father that he <u>would skype into the meeting</u>.
- **3.** He explains the neologism (new word) "phigital" by saying that there is a digital equivalent for every physical element.
- **4.** The speaker alleges that the elimination of the line between the physical and digital world has happened in the "formative years" in which the generational personality is crafted.
- **5.** He illustrates his theory by explaining different perceptions of various generations when it comes to <u>space exploration</u>.
